



## Louis Uresk, D.D.S.

March 31, 1927 - November 26, 2018

Louis Uresk, D.D.S., age 91 of Elgin passed away unexpectedly at his home on Monday, November 26, 2018. Louis was born on his family's ranch in Myton, Utah on March 31, 1927 and was the son of the late Matthew & Ursula (nee Skoflanc) Uresk. He was raised in Utah and had many fond memories of growing up during the depression, working hard and always having food to eat. Louis grew up in a large family that remains very close. He looked forward to the yearly family reunion in Utah and barbeque which has been going on yearly since 1922. Louis was a graduate of Utah State Agriculture College and then attended Northwestern University Dental School where he earned his Doctor of Dental Science. Louis practiced dentistry in Elgin for 58 years until his retirement in 2012 and was a member of the American Dental Association. In earlier years he was involved in Boy Scouting and had served as a Troop Leader. Louis was also a member of the First United Methodist Church of Elgin. He was very kind, thoughtful and generous. He truly enjoyed people, traveling, cooking for others, and he especially loved spending time with his daughter Rene. Louis raised sheep for 29 years and spent a lot of time at his farm in Wisconsin. Survivors include his daughters; Ann and Rene and his three grandchildren; Larisa (Eric) Butters, Forrest and Crane Herr and his great grandson; William Butters.
